As in "real" BINGO, there are also other ways you can win. There are 12 different ways to BINGO: horizontal, vertical, and diagonal lines.

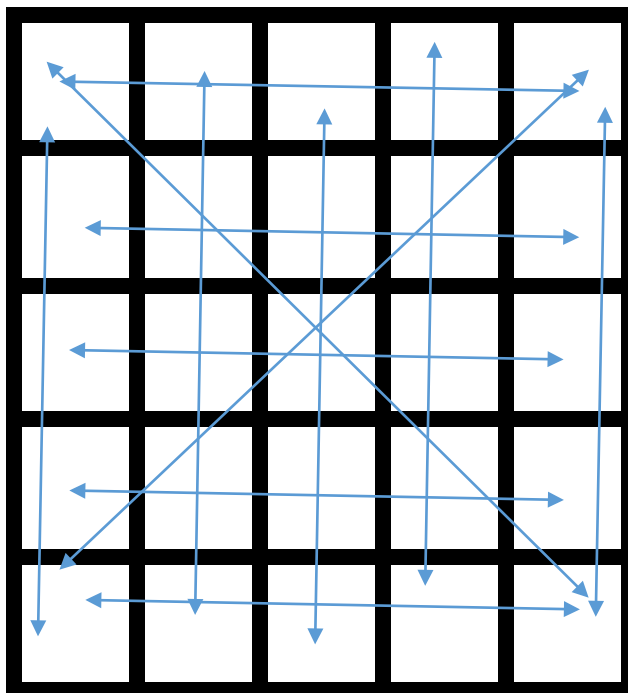
Definitions of BINGO
