SUPPLY LIST AND INFORMATION

2022-2023

We will require a **CERTIFICATION OF IMMUNIZATION COMPLIANCE** for each kindergarten student who is enrolled. This may be obtained from either your doctor or the health department. Also required is a **COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE** and **SOCIAL SECURITY CARD**. These documents will be a part of the student's permanent records. **THESE ARE DUE ON REGISTRATION DAY.**

SUPPLY LIST:

2 boxes of **WASHABLE** "classic" (10 count) Crayola markers (broad line, not fine line)

2 boxes of facial tissues

2 rolls of paper towels (girls)

1 box Band-Aids (boys)

4 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons

2 pkgs. # 2 pencils wooden (Dixon TICONDEROGA – 24 pack)

1 pair safety scissors (Children's Fiskars recommended)

12 glue sticks

Clorox Wipes

1 can Lysol (Girls)

4 EXPO dry erase markers (**black ONLY**, skinny, fine tip)

2 boxes Ziplock bags (1 quart & 1 gallon) **slider closure ONLY**

Baby wipes

1 large Germ X (Boys)

2 heavy duty **large** zippered pencil bags-**canvas w/window**

SNACKS:

Each child will supply snacks for our whole class for a week at a time. We will work up a schedule and let you know when it is your turn to furnish the snack for the week (please, nothing elaborate, just something to tide the students over until lunch). Please send nutritious snacks. SUGGESTIONS: Graham crackers, peanut butter and crackers, popcorn, cookies, etc.

CLOTHES:

On the first day of school, please send an extra set of clothes (undies, socks, t-shirt, long pants) for your child which will be kept at school to use in case of an accident. (Children have been known to slip down in mud on the playground and have to call their parents at home or at work to bring them dry clothing. Children also spill drinks on themselves and each other. There really is the possibility of more than ONE KIND OF ACCIDENT!)

ALSO, package the clothes in a ziplock bag marked with your child's name on the bag. Since these clothes will possibly be kept all school year, send a worn pair of jeans and a shirt that you reasonably expect will not be too tight in seven or eight months. **This does not have to be a school uniform.**
